You are kindly invited to contribute with your scientific works. This is an extraordinary opportunity to exchange your experiences and to showcase your research in the field of urological cancers.

Before submitting your abstract, please read the guidelines.

Guidelines for Preparation

The length of the abstract should not exceed 350 words excluding the title, authors' details, figure (if present) but including the word count of table (if present) and table/figure title and legends. A title of no more than 100 characters (spaces included) that clearly indicates the nature of the investigation needs to be provided.

The authors' names (full first names, family names) and affiliations (Institution, City, Country) must be shown.

Abbreviations should be avoided in the abstract title but may be used in the text if they are defined at first usage.

The abstract should be as informative as possible:

1. State the specific **objective** of the study
2. State the **methods** used
3. Summarize the **results** obtained
4. State the **conclusions** reached
5. List the **acknowledgements** if applicable

A maximum of 10 authors can be added during submission of your abstract. In case there are more than 10 authors, please use a group name or include those in the acknowledgements. Please ensure that your abstract does not contain spelling, grammatical or scientific errors.

Guidelines for Submission

Abstracts may be submitted only electronically via the Abstract submission web platform.

Abstracts must be submitted by July 10, 2026, h. 11:59 pm CET.

- ✓ Abstracts sent by mail, email or fax will not be accepted.
- ✓ Please use Calibri font, size 12
- ✓ Please do not use any highlighting
- ✓ The abstract should be structured as indicated in the guidelines above. One table or figure (of max 2 panels) can be included with its own descriptive title of no more than 10-15 words, as well as an explanatory figure legend.
- ✓ Present numerical results (eg, absolute numbers, proportions, rates, ratios, or differences) with appropriate indicators of uncertainty, such as confidence intervals. Avoid relying solely on statistical hypothesis testing, such as the use of P values, which fails to convey important quantitative information.
- ✓ Abstracts can be saved in draft status and updated before the deadline.
- ✓ Once you have submitted your abstract, you will receive an automatic email confirmation.
If you do not receive an email, please contact e.ripa@planning.it.
- ✓ All abstracts will be reviewed, scored and accepted or rejected by the Scientific Committee.

- ✓ You will be notified of your submission's acceptance status via e-mail
- ✓ Abstracts will be evaluated and selected by the Scientific Committee, based on the following criteria: Focus on the following topics, Originality, Scientific interest, Accuracy of materials and method, Completeness and relevance of the results, Appropriateness of conclusions.
- ✓ The submission system will generate a temporary submission number that must be used in all correspondence. If you do not receive this number immediately after your submission by email, it means that your abstract has not been registered.
- ✓ Choose one primary topic listed on the website which best corresponds to the content of your abstract.

Topics in Urological Cancers:

Real world evidence (except case studies)
Clinical trials analyses or sub-analyses
Clinical trial designs (if already registered)
Translational science
Cost-effectiveness or cost-efficacy analyses
Epidemiology
